Requirements for a minor in Religious Studies – N820

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

At least six (6) credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, *excluding* transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of coursework in Religious Studies, including at least nine (9) hours at the upper-division level. Students must take one of the introductory courses listed in Section I of the Religious Studies major requirements, then choose the remaining 15 hours from among the list of approved courses for the major. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. One of the following for the introductory course requirement:
ANTH 1823, *Religion in Everyday Life*
PHIL 1203, *Philosophy & Human Destiny, East and West*
PHIL 2403, *Introduction to Philosophy of Religion*
RELS 1113, *Introduction to Religious Studies*
RELS 2003, *Special Topics in Introduction to Religious Studies*
RELS 2403, *Introduction to Comparative Religion*
RELS 2413, *Religion, Culture, and the Meaning of Life*

2. Fifteen (15) hours, chosen from among the list of approved courses for the major.

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Department of Religious Studies.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
